# THE PROGRAM

#### THE LOCATION

# **SELECTION PROCESS**

PTI participants are chosen by a qualified screening committee from applications submitted and received by BIZPAC. Preliminary applications must be received no later than September 28, 2011. Secondary applications must be received by October 5, 2011.

# INVESTMENT

The cost of investing in PTI is time and tuition. The program consists of weekly, three-hour sessions for a total of four weeks. Tuition is \$95 per person. Participants are responsible for paying their own tuition or for making arrangements for payment by their employer and/or sponsoring organization. The fee and secondary application must be submitted prior to Wednesday, October 5, 2011.
